

The Ins and Outs of Knife Opening in CS: GO

Note: The exact possibility for a particular knife [case opening](#) (e.g., Karambit|Fade) is a fraction of the unusual special item pool.

These numbers show that the frustrating majority of openings will produce standard skins, not knives. The low likelihood makes knife openings a high-risk, high-reward activity.

Popular Knife Types and Market Values

Knife skins are categorized by their rarity and visual appeal. Below is a table summarizing some of the most sought-after knives and their common market value varieties (as of early 2026):

- **Comprehend the Odds**-- Recognize that the vast majority of openings will not yield a knife. The expected return is unfavorable.
- **Avoid Chasing Losses**-- If a gamer invests an established spending plan without obtaining a knife, it is advisable to stop instead of attempt to "recover" losses.
