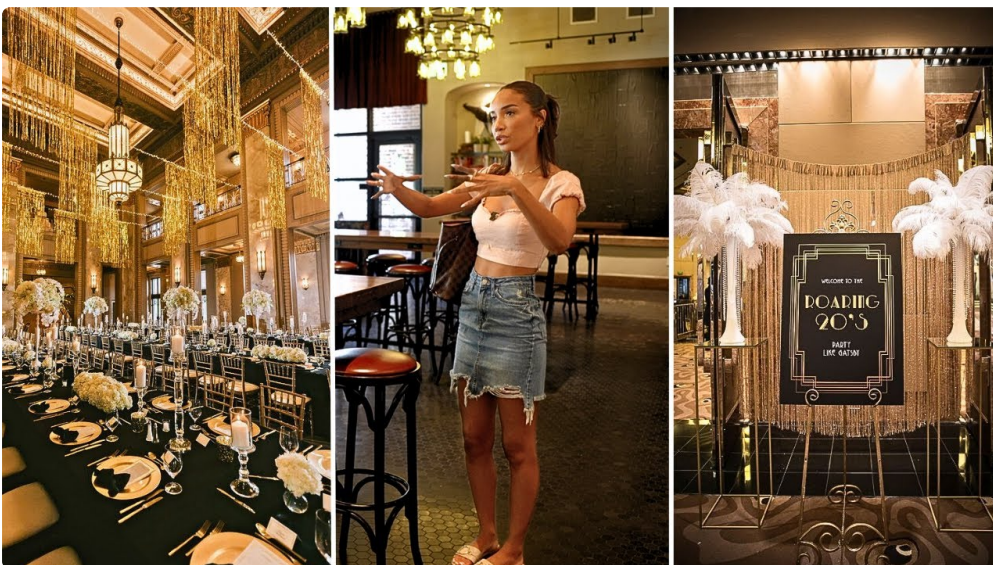
A vendor doesn't show up: This is when your specialist's contacts pay off. They'll have backup professionals they can call at a moment's notice.
