A straightforward 1v1 video game mode where 2 players wager equivalent skin values. A virtual coin is turned, offering each individual a roughly 50% chance to double their stock or lose it entirely.

5. Jackpot

Several players pool their skins into a main pot. A wheel spins, and a winner is picked. The greater a gamer's contributed value relative to the total pot, the greater their analytical chance of winning the whole swimming pool.
