

What garage door issues need qualified repair?

An **overhead garage door** is a heavy, counterweighted system that includes panels, tracks, rollers, cables, springs, and an opener. A problem with any one of these components can prevent safe operation or create additional damage. Professional garage door repair is usually appropriate when the door is jammed, unusually heavy, crooked, loud, damaged, or unable to stay open.
