As seen in the table above, the lower numbers appear most frequently, while the financially rewarding reward rounds are much rarer, including high-volatility excitement to the gameplay.

The Four Wild and Wonderful Bonus Rounds

The true magic of *Crazy Time* depend on its 4 reward video games. Activating one of these rounds transports gamers from the main studio into immersive, interactive enhanced truth mini-games.

1. Coin Flip

This is the easiest and most regular reward round.

- **How it works:** A coin with a red side and a blue side is flipped by a mechanical flipper.
- **The Payout:** Before the flip, random multipliers are designated to both the red and blue sides. Whichever side lands face up figures out the multiplier applied to the gamer's stake.

2. Cash Hunt

Step up to a massive virtual shooting gallery.

- **How it works:** The screen displays a grid of 108 random multipliers hidden behind various symbols (like a cactus, a target, or a chef's hat).
- **The Payout:** Players use an on-screen cannon to aim and shoot at one symbol before a countdown timer expires. As soon as the timer ends, all symbols expose their concealed multipliers, and the player wins whatever worth their selected symbol concealed.

3. Pachinko

Motivated by the traditional Japanese arcade game, Pachinko is all about gravity and anticipation.

- **How it works:** The dealership drops a puck from the top of a radiant purple Pachinko wall filled with physical pegs. The puck bounces randomly down the board until it lands in among the landing zones at the bottom.
- **The Payout:** Each zone consists of a multiplier. If the puck lands in a "DOUBLE" zone, all multipliers on the board double, and the puck is dropped once again for massive potential payments.

4. Crazy Time

The supreme feature of the video game, occurring behind a massive red door.

- **How it works:** The host opens the door to reveal a surreal, huge virtual wheel with 64 sectors and 3 flippers (Green, Blue, and Yellow).
- **The Payout:** The gamer must pick one of the three flippers. The wheel is spun, and whichever multiplier the selected flipper points to when the wheel stops is awarded to the player. Just like Pachinko, landing on "DOUBLE" or "TRIPLE" increases all worths on the wheel for a re-spin.

- **Covering the Board:** Some gamers choose to spread out small bets throughout several numbers and perk rounds to ensure they have a stake in almost every spin. However, this requires careful bankroll management, as covering too numerous outcomes can rapidly diminish funds if low-paying numbers keep striking.
