- **Markets**-- Platforms such as the Steam Community Market, Buff.163, or third-party skin sites (e.g., CSGOStash) list rare cases. Constantly verify the seller's reputation and usage escrow services.

4. **Diversify Portfolio**-- Don't put all capital in a single case. Spread investments throughout numerous unusual cases to reduce risk.
