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If you own a home in Arlington, you already understand what our climate does to exterior surface areas. One wet spring and a shaded side of your home can begin growing algae. A number of seasons of pollen and traffic dust will turn a bright driveway dull gray. Brick actions get slick. Composite decks collect mildew in the grain.

A cautious specialist will either avoid those locations or protect them, not simply spray and hope.

Plants can be pre-wet, gently covered, and rinsed again after treatment. On hot days, that additional care can be the distinction in between healthy landscaping and curled brown leaves 2 days later.

If the company seems proud of using "optimal power" everywhere, deal with that as a warning, not a selling point.
