A serious abode baker insisted on honed marble for a twelve-foot island. She accepts patina. We sealed it, informed the circle of relatives approximately citrus, and installed a small polished quartz slab on a nearby cart for espresso. The marble exhibits comfortable marks after two years, principally in the kneading neighborhood, yet it seems to be deliberately elderly instead of broken, which is exactly what she wanted.
