What is a Crazy Time Slot?

Hosted by an energetic live presenter in a lively, Willy Wonka-esque studio, the game centers around a huge, vertically mounted wheel including 54 sections.

Players place bets on numbers (1, 2, 5, or 10) or on one of the 4 distinct benefit rounds. If the wheel stops on the segment a player has wagered on, they win [crazy time demo casino](#) a payment or gain entry into an immersive mini-game.

Understanding the Betting Layout

Before the wheel spins, players have a restricted window to position their chips on the betting grid. The grid consists of eight unique wagering options, split equally in between standard numbers and reward triggers.

- **Number 1:** Appears 21 times on the wheel. Payment: 1:1.
- **Number 2:** Appears 13 times on the wheel. Payment: 2:1.
- **Number 5:** Appears 7 times on the wheel. Payment: 5:1.
- **Number 10:** Appears 4 times on the wheel. Payout: 10:1.
- **Coin Flip:** Appears 4 times on the wheel. Activates the Coin Flip bonus.
- **Cash Hunt:** Appears 2 times on the wheel. Activates the Cash Hunt bonus offer.

- **Pachinko:** Appears 2 times on the wheel. Sets off the Pachinko reward.
- **Crazy Time:** Appears 1 time on the wheel. Triggers the ultimate bonus round.

The Top Slot Feature: Amplifying the Action

Including a layer of traditional slot mechanics to the game, every single spin of the main wheel is accompanied by a **Top Slot** situated directly above the speaker and the wheel.

The Top Slot features 2 reels that spin concurrently:

1. **Reel 1:** Displays a betting spot (a number or a benefit round).
2. **Reel 2:** Displays a multiplier value (ranging from 2x up to 50x).

If *Bitz* the horizontal line in the Top Slot links a wagering spot with a multiplier, that multiplier is applied to the outcome of the main wheel spin, supplied the wheel arrive at that specific area. If a benefit round is increased, all prizes inside that bonus offer round are multiplied accordingly, causing the game's famous enormous payments.

Deep Dive: The Four Bonus Rounds

The primary allure of the Crazy Time slot experience depends on its 4 special bonus games. These mini-games transportation gamers far from the primary wheel and into augmented-reality environments.

1. Coin Flip

- **Frequency:** 4 sections on the wheel.
- **Mechanic:** A basic red and blue coin is turned by a mechanical flipper.
- **Payment:** Before the flip, random multipliers are appointed to both the red and blue sides of the coin. Whichever side lands deal with up identifies the player's multiplier win.

2. Cash Hunt

- **Frequency:** 2 sectors on the wheel.
- **Mechanic:** An enormous screen shows 108 random multipliers hidden behind shooting gallery targets (symbols like a cactus, target, hat, etc).
- **Payment:** Players utilize an on-screen cannon to intend and shoot at a target of their choice before time runs out, revealing the concealed multiplier underneath.

3. Pachinko

- **Frequency:** 2 segments on the wheel.
- **Mechanic:** Inspired by the standard Japanese arcade game, a glowing puck is dropped from the top of a huge wall filled with pegs.
- **Payment:** The puck bounces down the board until it lands in a multiplier slot at the bottom. If it strikes a "DOUBLE" slot, all multipliers on the board double, and the puck is dropped once again.

4. Crazy Time

- **Frequency:** 1 section on the wheel.
- **Mechanic:** Players travel through a red door into a virtual, psychedelic world featuring a huge giant wheel.

- **Payment:** Players select among 3 flippers (green, blue, or yellow). The speaker presses a huge red button to spin the huge wheel. It can yield multipliers up to 20,000 x if "DOUBLE" or "TRIPLE" sectors are struck along the way.

Methods for Playing the Crazy Time Slot

While Crazy Time is essentially a video game of chance governed by a random number generator (RNG) and physical wheel physics, gamers typically utilize various bankroll management techniques.

Common Approaches Include:

- **The Conservative Approach (Number Betting):** Focusing mainly on numbers 1 and 2. Due to the fact that these appear often on the wheel, this method intends to sustain a player's bankroll for longer durations, with periodic little wins.
- **The Bonus Hunter Strategy:** Wagering solely or heavily on the four bonus rounds (Coin Flip, Cash Hunt, Pachinko, Crazy Time). This method accepts a higher threat of frequent losses in exchange for the possibility to enter the high-paying perk mini-games.
- **The Balanced Spread:** Spacing bets across both numbers and benefit rounds to ensure that regular little wins from numbers can help money the pursuit of bonus functions.

Tips for a Responsible and Enjoyable Experience

Since the pacing of a live game show is fast and the environment is electric, it is easy to get caught up in the enjoyment. Keep these best practices in mind:

- **Set a Budget:** Decide beforehand how much cash you are willing to spend and stick strictly to that limit.

- **Treat it as Entertainment:** View your home edge and wagers as the cost of admission for an interactive home entertainment program rather than a reliable source of earnings.
- **Take Breaks:** Step far from the screen periodically to maintain a clear head.
