- Licenses from nations that signed the **1968 Vienna Convention on Road Traffic** can usually be exchanged straight, though tests might be needed depending on bilateral arrangements and residency period.
- Licenses from countries under the **1949 Geneva Convention** normally require passing the theoretical state exam.
