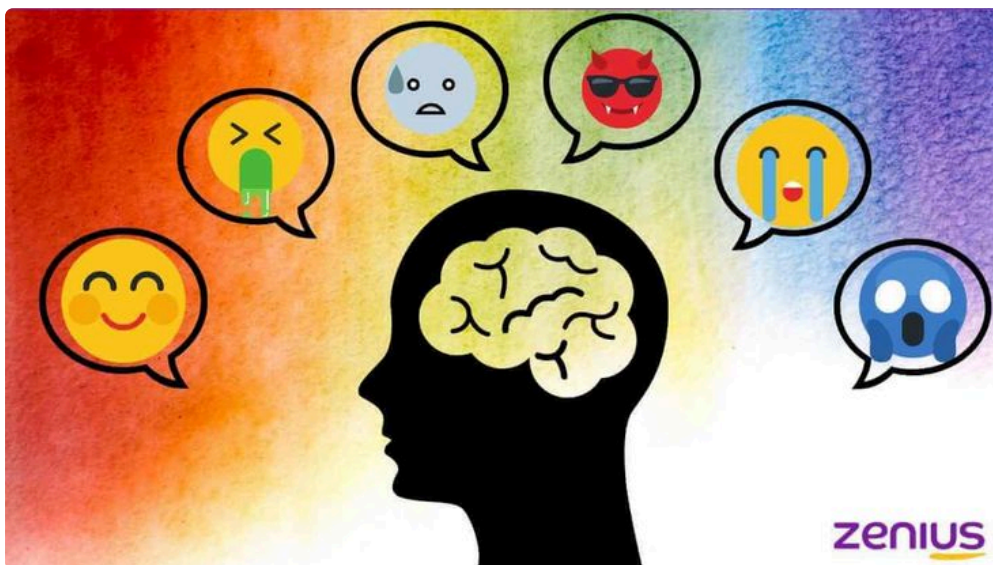


Things To Do In Costa Blanca: Piece De Resistances + Guidance

- View the Grandmother Circus Maximus show in Villajoyosa, which brings ancient Rome to life with an unbelievable mix of gladiator fights, chariot races and incredible performances!
- But Spain's gorgeous 'white coast' is much more than enjoyable and sun ... look into the inland valleys or trek the hills and you'll see what I indicate.
- You can go to old Moorish castles and contemporary museums and delight in all the delicious food the area has to offer.
- The walking begins on a well-kept path that gradually climbs up uphill.





A selection of global dining establishments provides for every single taste and pocket also, from burgers to pizza to kebab, Indian or Moroccan, Chinese or eat-as-much-as-you-like 'Asian', and essentially everything European consisting of English fish and chips! You'll also discover a yummy 'paella de verduras' which usually integrates neighborhood sun-ripened vegetables consisting of artichokes with a handful of butter beans.
