Changing wall colors can completely transform a space. Besides being one of the most easy and affordable renovations to accomplish, it is also one of the simplest to alter later on.

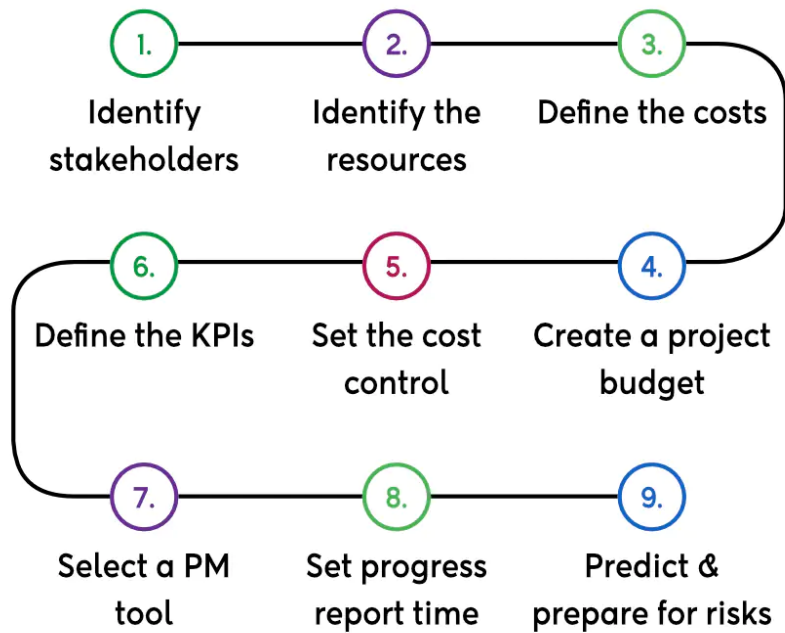
