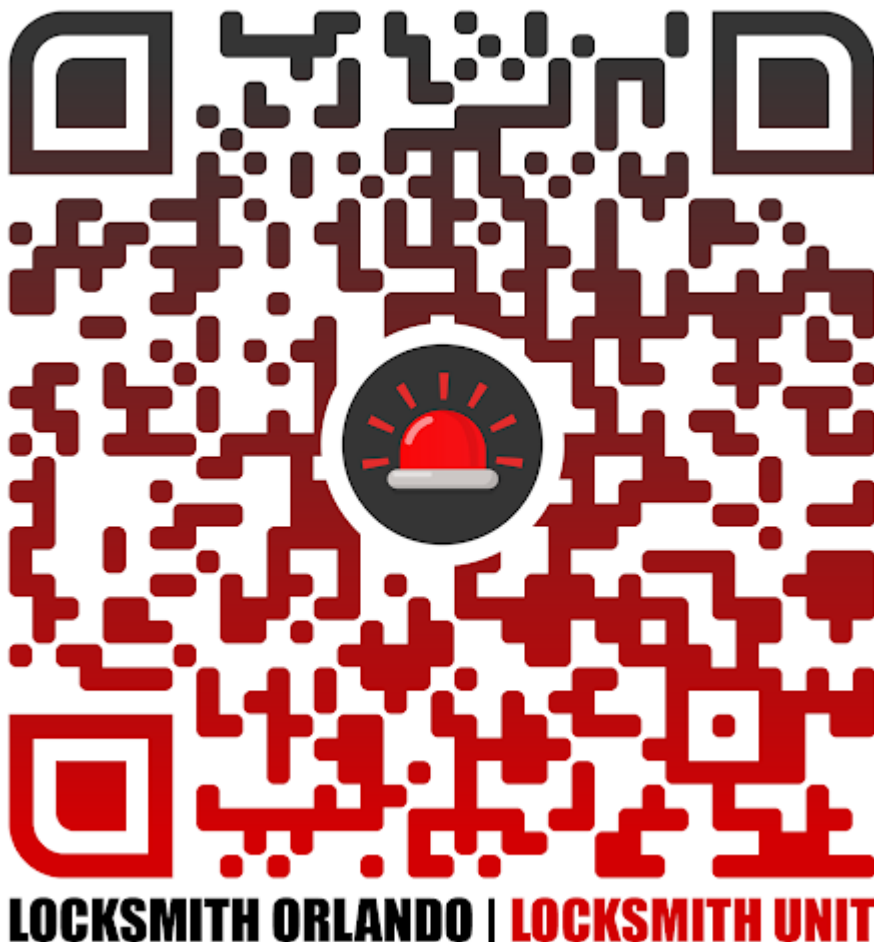
What keypad and electronic lock upgrades solve
