In a Victorian with complicated plaster cornices, the customer wanted complete-height cabinets to the ceiling. The cornice varied through well-nigh an inch across the room. Removing it should have erased a chunk of background. We designed a two-side crown at the shelves, with a small higher cap that may drift and be scribed to the plaster.
