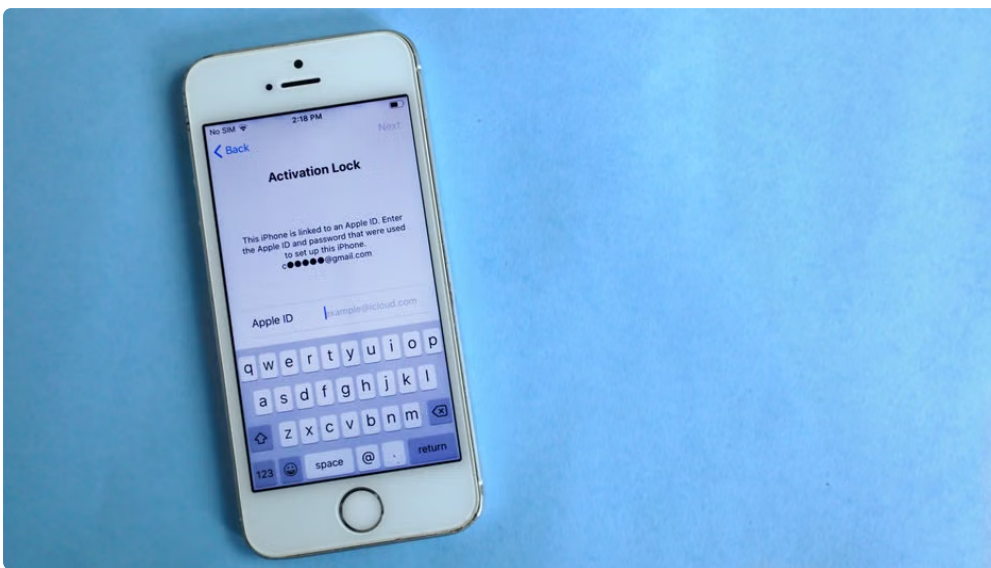

This is a common frustration, especially with apps like Bingoplus, where the form fields can get hidden behind the keyboard on some mobile devices.
