You can not live with roaches in the cooking area, bed insects in the headboard, or woodworker ants in the sill plate. behind small print. If a sales representative stands up to writing down information, prevent them. If a professional waits to show you product labels or safety information sheets upon demand, maintain your wallet in your pocket.
