A timeless 1v1 video game of opportunity. 2 players wager skins of approximately equal worth. The system designates one gamer as Heads and the other as Tails, then flips a virtual coin. The winner takes the entire pot, minus a little platform commission (rake).

5. Esports Match Betting

For fans of the expert scene (BLAST Premier, ESL Pro League, Majors), match betting is the go-to choice. Users wager on expert teams using chances determined by the platform, similar to standard sportsbooks.
