Technical capabilities and process depth

Compliance, cybersecurity, and data integrity

- Regulatory: ITAR/EAR controls for defense projects, RoHS/REACH for electronics, conflict minerals due diligence, and counterfeit parts mitigation per AS5553/6081 where relevant.
- Cybersecurity: For defense-related work, confirm NIST 800-171 adherence and CMMC readiness. NDA processes and secure data exchange (SFTP/PLM portals) are essential.
- Environmental, health, and safety: OSHA compliance, hazardous material handling, and documented training. Sustainability practices and energy management can be differentiators for Manufacturing services Groton CT.

Supply chain resilience and risk management

- Sub-tier oversight: Review their approved vendor list controls, incoming inspection rigor, and supplier scorecards. Evaluate how they qualify raw materials and critical coatings/platings.
