Pricing depends on the size of the closet, the materials chosen, and how many accessories like drawers or shoe racks are built in. A reach-in closet is a single-door opening, typically two to six feet wide, accessed from outside the space. A walk-in closet is large enough to

physically step into, generally starting around five feet by five feet. Closet Factory Knoxville designs both, maximizing every inch of a reach-in and adding more elaborate layouts, like islands or seating, in a larger walk-in. How much storage space can a custom closet system add? Because a standard wire shelf and rod setup wastes most of the vertical space in a closet, Knoxville clients regularly see close to double the practical storage capacity within the same physical footprint once a second hang zone, drawers, and taller shelving are added. Does Closet Factory Knoxville offer financing? Yes.
