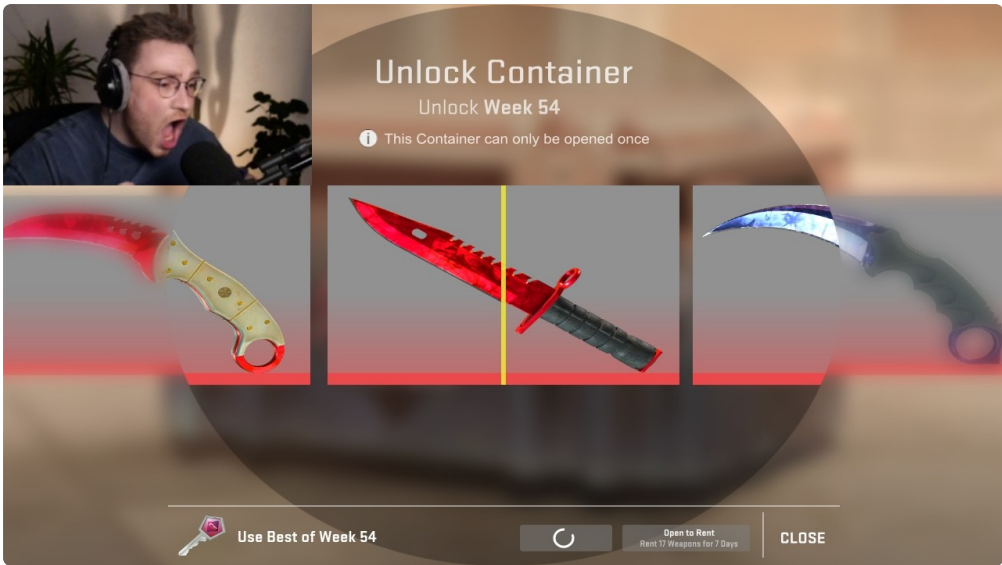

- The "Covert" rarity is the rarest tier and constantly appears as the bonus offer product (knife or gloves).
- The portions revealed are approximate and can move somewhat with each case spot.
- Prices on the Steam Market often exceed the in-game expense for extremely sought-after skins.

3. Why These Cases Matter

3.1 Economy Influence
