

A windshield looks simple from the driver's seat. Clear glass, a black border, maybe a camera housing behind the rearview mirror. Most people think about it only when a stone chip spreads overnight or a crack starts crawling across the lower edge. But the windshield is not just a weather barrier. It is part of the vehicle's safety structure, and in many cars it plays a direct role in how the passenger airbag performs during a crash.

That is why windshield replacement deserves more care than a quick price comparison. A low windshield replacement cost may look appealing until you consider what the glass, adhesive, installation method, and calibration work are actually responsible for.
