

A broken garage door can impact access, security, and daily routines. In Los Angeles, the appropriate repair depends on the door's age, style, exposure to the elements, and the part that has failed. Local circumstances also matter. Why will an overhead garage door not operate or close?

If the opener runs but the door does not move, the trolley, drive gear, limit settings, or connection between the opener and door may need attention.

A garage door will not close when the photo-eye sensors are obstructed, dirty, misaligned, or damaged. These sensors sit near the bottom of the tracks and must be aligned with each other. Wipe their lenses carefully and remove objects, leaves, or storage items from the sensor path. Do not bypass the sensors because they are an essential part of garage door safety.

Track alignment is another common cause. A bent garage door track, loose mounting bracket, or damaged roller can make the door bind or reverse. Do not force the door or continue cycling it if it rubs, shakes, or drops unevenly. Continued use can transform a minor alignment issue into a cable, panel, or opener problem.



When does a broken spring require immediate service?

A broken garage door spring requires prompt professional attention because the spring supports much of the door's weight. A torsion spring is mounted above the door, while an extension spring is positioned along the horizontal tracks. Either type can break with a sharp sound, leave a visible gap, or cause the door to become very heavy.

Never try to lift a heavy door with a broken spring, remove the spring, or adjust garage door spring tension. The stored energy can cause serious injury. Keep all children and vehicles away from the door until a technician arrives. Spring replacement should normally include an inspection of the cables, drums, rollers, hinges, bearings, and mounting points. Replacing an opener will not correct a door that is too heavy, bent, or poorly balanced. If the garage door opener strains, reverses, or repeatedly stops, an inspection should identify whether the underlying problem is the spring system, track alignment, rollers, or cables.

Should you fix a garage door panel or replace it?

A garage door panel may be fixed when the damage is limited, limited to a small dent, or related to hardware that can be replaced. A panel with significant cracks, crushed sections, rust-through, or distorted framing may require panel replacement. If the replacement panel is no longer manufactured or does not match the color and design, replacing the entire door may deliver a better result.
