What Is a Pre-Event Site Survey?

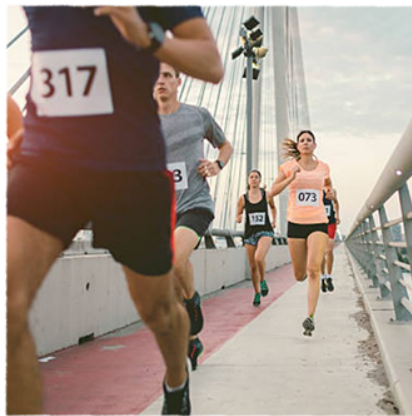

The Physical Layout

The initial and most basic component is the physical space itself. Kollysphere calculates the exact dimensions of the trade show venue—length, width, and ceiling height. We determine any pillars, columns, or obstructions that might influence display placement. We examine the flooring surface and its weight-bearing capability, which is crucial for substantial exhibits. And we evaluate the availability of storage space for empty crates and materials.



The Technical Side

The subsequent vital component is the venue's utilities and infrastructure. Kollysphere checks the availability and [event management event company event organizer malaysia](#) location of electrical outlets, the voltage and amperage available, and whether additional power will need to be supplied. We also inspect the lighting, the airflow, the water supply, and the online connectivity on offer at the space.

The Movement

We check the route from the loading bay to the booth location, identifying any narrow turns, narrow doorways, or elevators that might pose obstacles. We also review the move-in and move-out timetables and any restrictions on access times.
