Armor + utility, or high-tier handguns (P250/Deagle) without armor. **Eco Round** A saving round where the group spends little to no money. Base handguns, perhaps a couple of flashbangs, saving for the next round. **Force Buy** Buying weapons despite a low bank to catch the challenger off guard. SMGs (MP9/Mac-10), Deagles, or Scout with no/light armor. **Full Buy** Optimum financial health. Buying the very best rifles and complete utility. Rifles (AK-47/ M4A4), full armor/helmet, full energy, and a Defuse Kit (CT).

Key Tactical Elements in CS2

1. The New Smoke Meta

- **Interact Clearly:** Callouts should be succinct. Instead of stating *"He's over there!"*, state *"One gamer, low health, holding ramp with an AWP."*
