

Spray foam can be damaged by later construction work, movement, water exposure, removal of equipment, or physical impact. An inspection may be appropriate when foam has visible gaps, cracks, missing sections, or areas disturbed by another trade.

The first step is identifying why the damage occurred. If water has entered the assembly, the source should be found and corrected. If wiring, plumbing, roofing, or structural work created the opening, that work should be complete before the insulation is restored.

A repair plan should define the affected area and determine whether surrounding material remains properly attached and in suitable condition. Simply covering the visible surface may not correct a deeper problem. Loose, contaminated, or damaged material may require additional preparation.

Compatibility also matters. The installer should know what material is present and select an appropriate repair method. The completed work should reconnect the insulation and air-control layer as consistently as practical without covering components that require access.

Property owners should avoid describing every uneven foam surface as failure. Some texture variation is normal. The key questions are whether the material is attached, whether intended coverage is continuous, and whether the assembly is functioning as designed.
