Confirming parking availability and any building-specific move-in requirements ahead of time helps avoid delays, especially in high-rise buildings that may require elevator reservations similar to other apartment communities across the city.

Checking whether a specific address falls within a designated no-parking zone during certain hours, common near campus during the academic year, also prevents an unexpected parking citation on move day.

Students moving from a dorm into off-campus housing for the first time should also plan for items not typically needed in dormitory living, such as kitchen supplies and additional furniture for a larger living space.

Creating a shared shopping list with roommates for these new household items helps avoid unnecessary duplicate purchases once everyone has moved into the shared space.

Storage Options Between Semesters

Students who need to store belongings over summer break or between leases benefit from short-term storage options rather than transporting everything home and back again. Planning this storage need ahead of the move-out date helps avoid a last-minute scramble to find a solution.
