The best locksmith help is the help that fits the problem

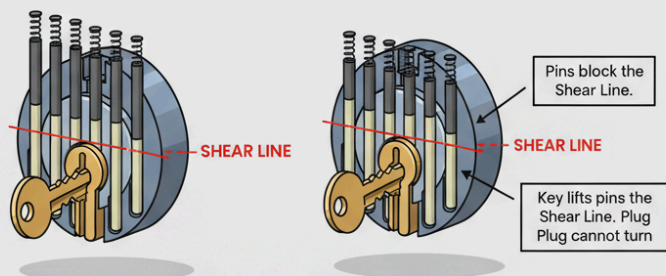

Each task is different, but the standard is the same, restore access, restore security, and do it in a way the customer can understand. For Orlando residents and business owners, that is the real benchmark for service. That

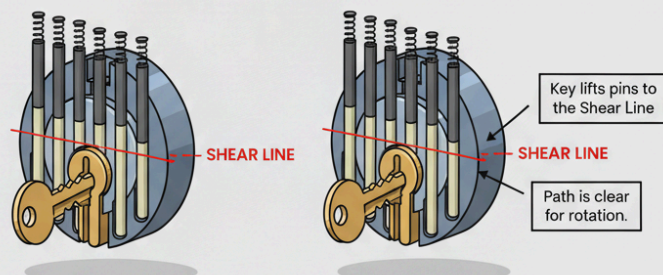
is the kind of service people remember when they search again for a locksmith near me.
