Covert (Red)~ 0.65%  
Rare Special Item (Knife)~ 0.26%

These numbers highlight that the overwhelming majority of openings will produce basic skins, not knives. The low possibility makes knife openings a high-risk, high-reward activity.

## Tips for Responsible Knife Opening

- Set a Budget**-- Decide beforehand just how much you want to spend. Treat the cash as home entertainment expense, not a financial investment.
- Understand the Odds**-- Recognize that the huge bulk of openings will not yield a knife. The expected return is unfavorable.
