to such structure, and the preservation of their structural stability to such extent of further work, it is deemed
desirable to place certain restrictions on the herein above described properties.

NOW THEREFORE, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That the above-specified Parties do hereby
agree and execute the following covenants, and conditions which should be and are hereby agreed upon and
incorporated with the land, to wit:

1. "Party Wall" shall mean and refer to the dividing wall between each adjoining dwelling unit. Any matter
concerning a Party Wall which are governed by the terms of this Agreement shall be governed by the general
rules of law regarding party walls. "Party Fence" shall mean and refer to the structure between separating the two
lots. Any matter concerning Party Fence which are not covered by the terms of this Agreement shall be
governed by the general rules of law concerning party fences.

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
