If the garage door will not close, inspect the garage door safety sensors near the bottom of both vertical tracks. The sensors must face each other and have a clear path. Dust buildup, accidental movement, sunlight interference, or loose wiring can cause the opener to reverse. Cleaning the lenses and checking alignment may resolve a simple sensor issue, but electrical or wiring faults should be handled by a technician.

Garage door cables deserve particular attention. Worn, slack, or separated garage door cables can make one side of the door to lift higher than the other. Avoid attempting to remove a spring or cable under tension. These components can release substantial force and cause major injury.

Typical indications of a weakened spring include a door that suddenly feels heavy, a visible gap in the spring, loud snapping sounds, slow operation, or an opener that struggles to lift the door. A trustworthy company should explain the diagnosis and provide a written estimate before beginning non-emergency work.
