- Look at the end of each vertical track. If you see corrosion flakes or frayed cord hairs, stop using the door till serviced.

Rollers and hinges. Home builders typically install spending plan nylon or thin steel rollers to strike a price point. After a couple of periods they oval out and rattle. Upgrading to sealed bearing nylon rollers alters the door from loud and angry to smooth and silent. Joints stop working where they neck down near the barrel. A split hinge tosses the door panel out of positioning and can crease a section if ignored.
