4. Heat, vacuum, and pressure balanced for our climate

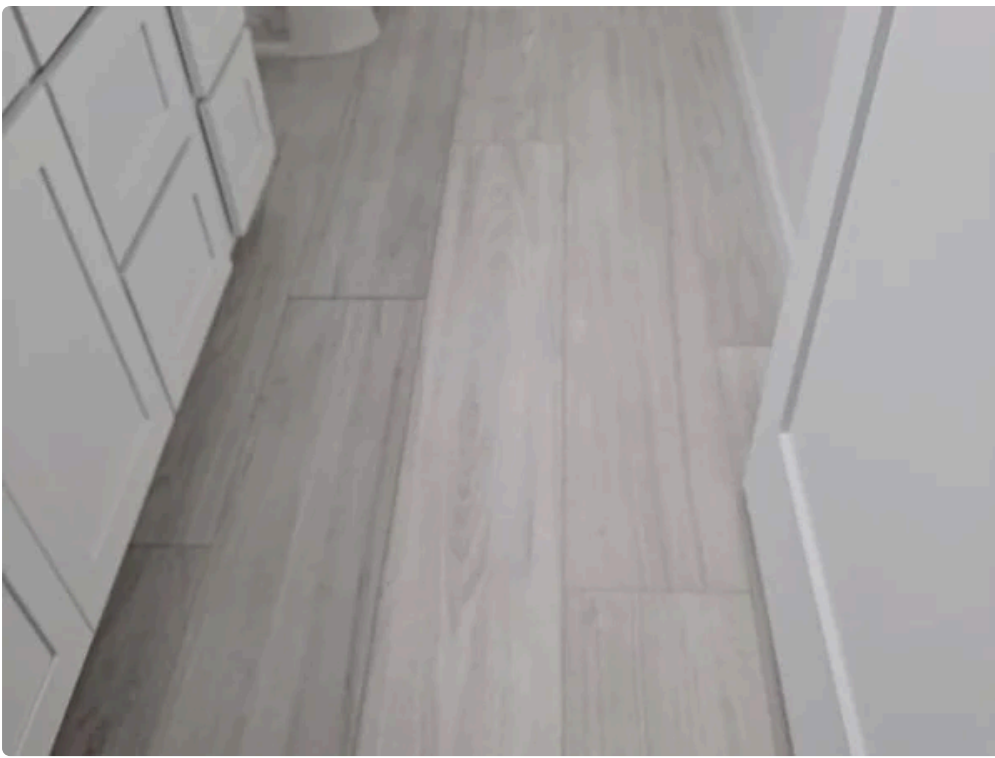
