On the shade side, spotted and variegated blends use multiple extruders to mix tones through the cap layer, not spray on top. That indicates when you scuff it with a mower wheel, the color reads real as opposed to exposing a white scar.

I have a wrinkle of a subdivision where the building board would only accept stained timber or rock for several years. The board chair finally changed their tune after

walking a fencing line we mounted in a clay-brown variegated design with deep embossing. We brought a sample board and a bread knife to their conference and let them scrape it. The knife missed without leaving the intense crease older vinyl used to show. Authorization adhered to in 2 months, after that six more backyards signed on.

If shade long life maintains you up in the evening, search for light reflectance data and warranties that particularly attend to fade to a Delta E array, not simply unclear discuss weathering. Long service warranties are very easy to assurance, but just a couple of suppliers tie them to measurable color stability. Stronger bones for wind and impact
