That formulation almost always involves cleaning, mechanical abrasion, spot priming, caulking, patching, and, in simple terms then, topcoats. 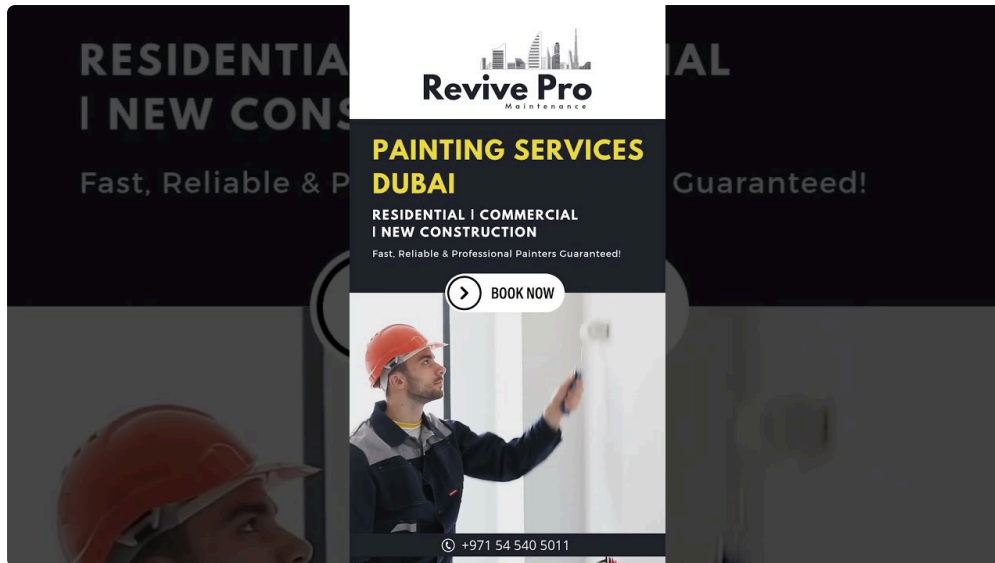

We checked moisture at questionable trim - readings hovered at 12 to fourteen % after a dry spell - then primed with a tannin-blocking off acrylic on sanded cedar. We back-brushed two coats of a satin acrylic at the frame and used a a little cut down sheen on the crown facts to store glare down underneath the afternoon sun.

The home-owner told me later that the most competitive fee spent turned into now not the paint logo but the time budgeted for caulking and see-priming at elevation.
