- Perform one test activity (download, submit, or recognize something) so you understand the operations functions

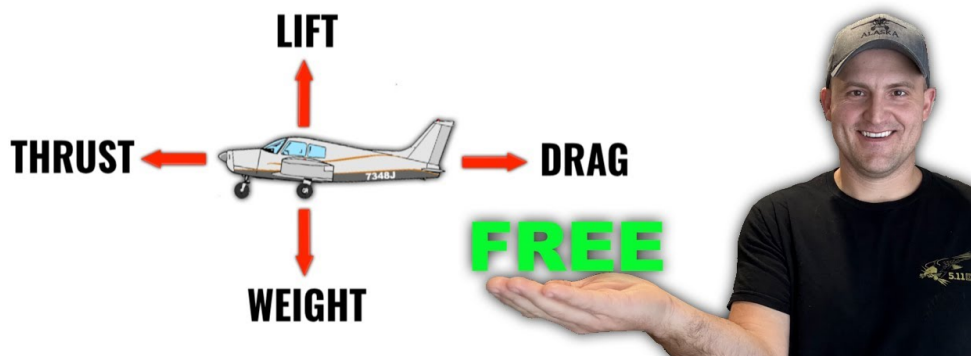
You are not trying to make the most of attributes. You are attempting to remove unpredictability. In air travel training, unpredictability is what produces preventable delays.

A reasonable weekly regimen that maintains you ahead of admin pressure

Keeping documents and remaining accountable
