We scheduled utility within the morning shade, laid two thin coats, and pronounced an overhang-hooked up coloration to minimize direct sun from midday to two. Three years on, the colour reads robust with simply a cushy shift you could expect on a red.

Another owner of a house got stable center MDF slab doorways and needed a tumbler-delicate, close to piano conclude. We establish stands, vacuumed the shop twice, wore lint-unfastened sleeves, and filtered the paint. After an adhesion primer, we carried out a excessive construct teeth, then wet sanded among coats with six hundred grit. The final coat went on with an HVLP gun at low pressure. The result pondered daylight like a replicate. It took longer than the patron estimated, however the doors nonetheless draw compliments, and so they refreshing with a damp microfiber devoid of haze.

Maintenance that clearly extends life
