Partial packing can also be a practical option. You may ask professional movers to pack fragile items, artwork, mirrors, electronics, kitchens, or other belongings that need extra protection.

Request Detailed Written Estimates

Ask several moving companies for written estimates based on the same information. Provide a complete inventory, current and destination addresses, moving date, property access details, stairs, elevators, parking conditions, and requested services.

For local California moves, moving companies may provide estimates only in writing after conducting a visual inspection of the goods to be moved. This rule helps create a more accurate estimate and protects consumers from vague verbal or online-only pricing.

Review the estimate for labor, travel time, truck use, packing, materials, fuel, furniture padding, stairs, elevators, long carries, storage, disassembly, reassembly, and possible additional charges.

Questions to Ask About Pricing

Ask whether the company charges hourly, by distance, through a flat rate, or based on another pricing structure. Find out whether there is a minimum number of hours and whether travel time is included.

Confirm deposit requirements, cancellation terms, rescheduling policies, payment methods, weekend rates, holiday pricing, and charges for delays. These details can affect your total cost significantly.

Be cautious if a moving company cannot explain its pricing clearly. A reliable provider should be willing to answer questions and put essential details in writing.

Check Credentials Before Booking

Choosing a cheap mover should never mean ignoring licensing and insurance. Ask local movers for California licensing information, business details, insurance information, and the company's procedure for handling damaged or missing belongings.

For interstate moves, verify that the moving company has a USDOT number and appropriate federal authority. Ask whether the company is a carrier or a broker. A carrier transports your belongings directly, while a broker arranges transportation with another moving company.

Request an explanation of valuation coverage. Basic carrier liability may not fully protect expensive items, so understand the available options, limits, exclusions, and claims process before the move begins.

Plan Parking and Access Early

Pack Smart and Stay Organized
