For gates and hardware zones, cast off latches and hinges while sensible. If removing will never be plausible, mask fastidiously and reassemble with corrosion resistant screws. 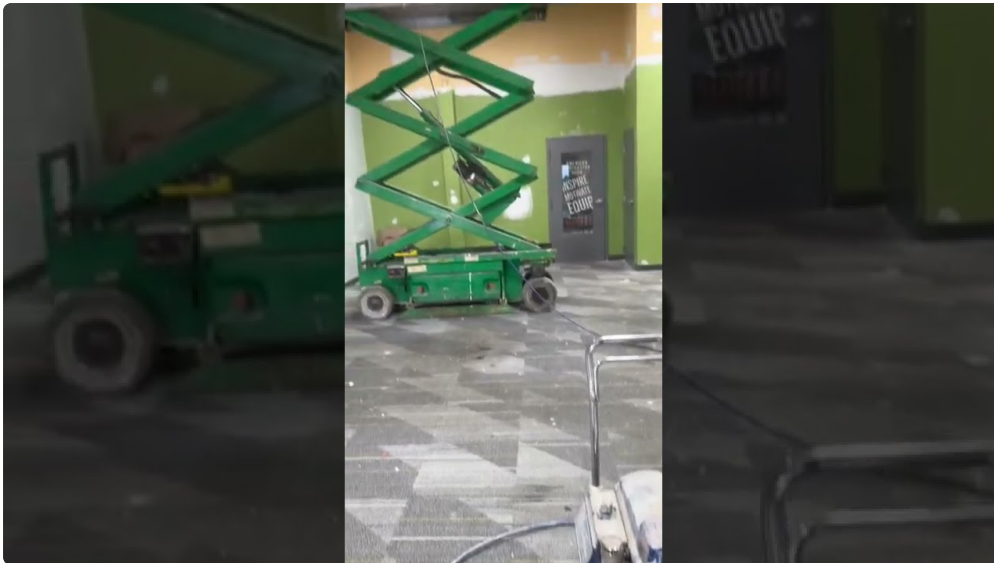
