When I changed the prop with one that matched my hand larger, the trick felt prefer it belonged to me. Suddenly the timing clicked. That is the topic of smart prop preference: convenience creates consistency.

## **Start with reliability, not flash**

A newbie's first mistake is chasing spectacle. Flashy props are enjoyable, but they typically demand extra from you. They would possibly require unique angles, explicit lights, or greater misdirection. They can also be fragile or fiddly.

Reliable props, having said that, present repetition. They let you follow the comparable go one hundred times with no the prop combating to come back.

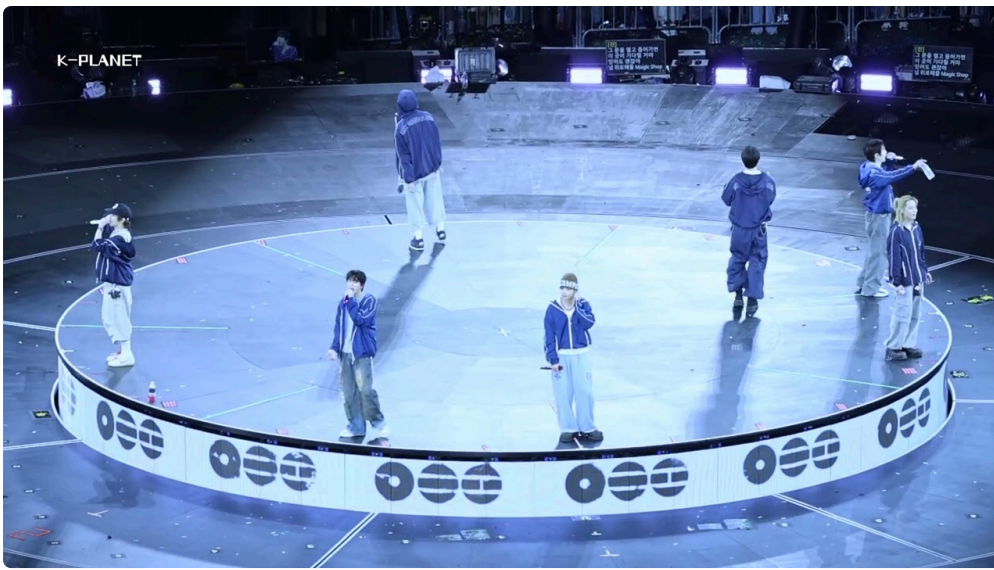
