The Neon Dance Floor

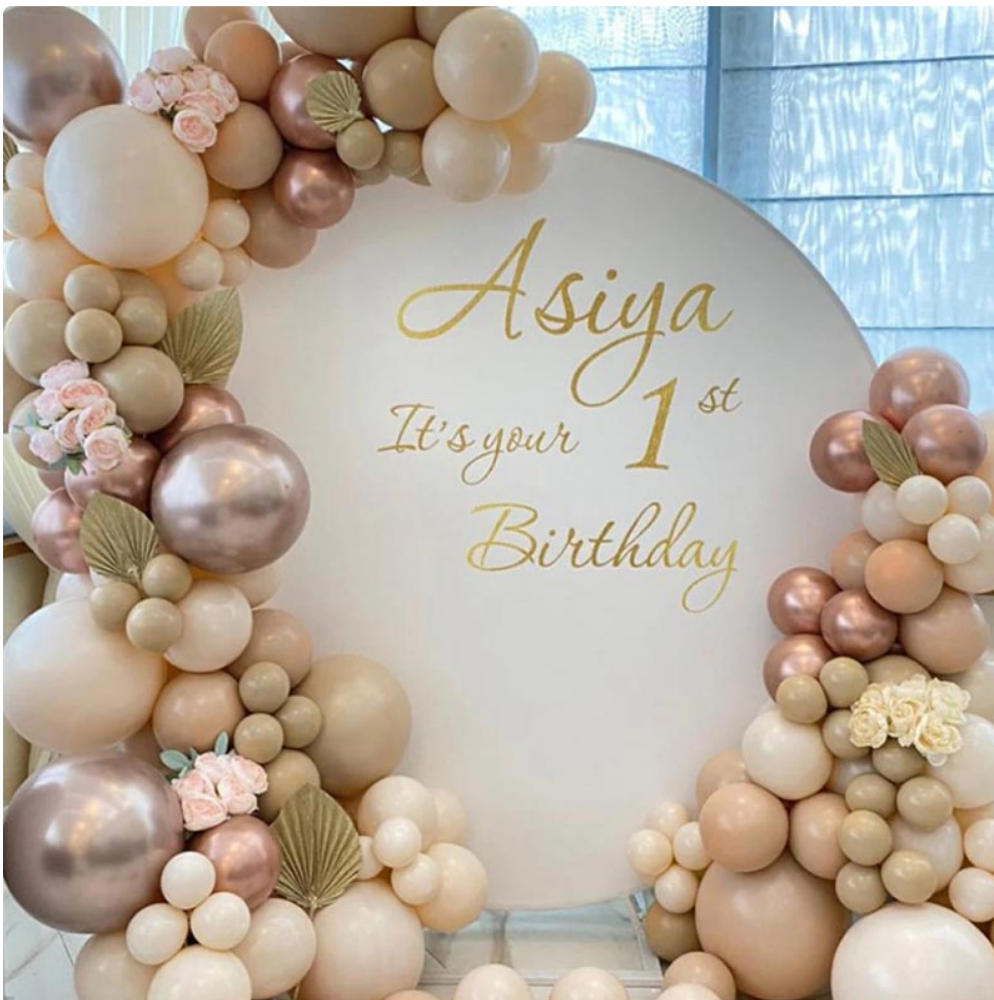
