Covert (Red)	~ 0.65%
Rare Special Item (Knife)	~ 0.26%

Note: The precise possibility for a specific knife (e.g., Karambit|Fade) is a portion of the unusual unique item pool.

These numbers illustrate that the overwhelming majority of openings will produce standard skins, not knives. The low probability makes knife openings a high-risk, high-reward activity.

Popular Knife Types and Market Values

Elements That Influence Knife Opening Outcomes

4. **Drift Value**-- The in-game float (wear) identifies the visual condition of the skin. Lower float values (closer to 0) are better.

Tips for Responsible Knife Opening

- **Set a Budget**-- Decide beforehand just how much you want to spend. Treat the cash as home entertainment cost, not an investment.
- **Comprehend the Odds**-- Recognize that the vast bulk of openings will not yield a knife. The expected return is unfavorable.
- **Prevent Chasing Losses**-- If a player invests a predetermined budget without obtaining a knife, it is advisable to stop instead of effort to "recover" losses.
- **Consider Trading**-- Once a knife is obtained, players can keep it expecting future rate appreciation or trade it instantly for other items or money.

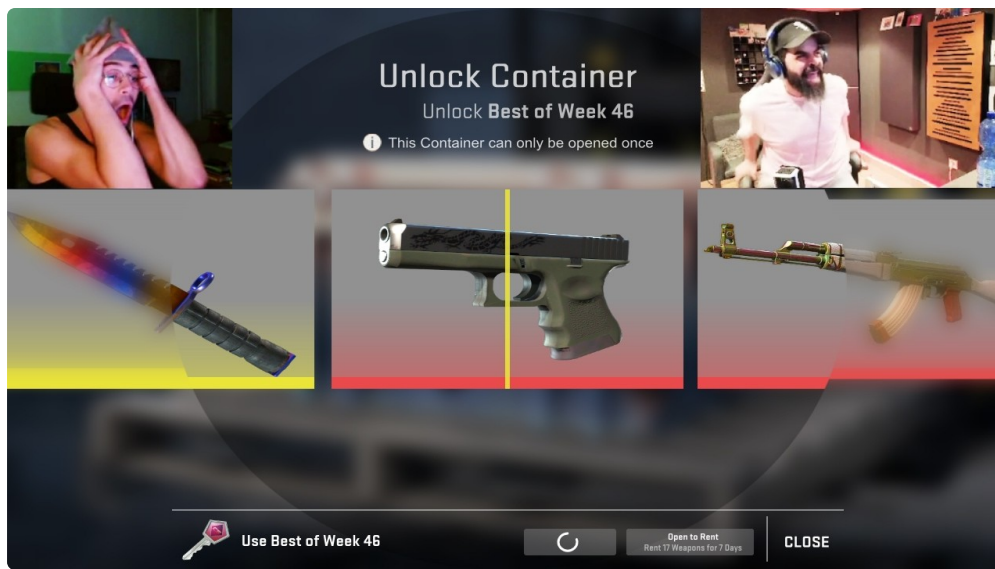
Common Misconceptions
