Getting the count right without overbuying

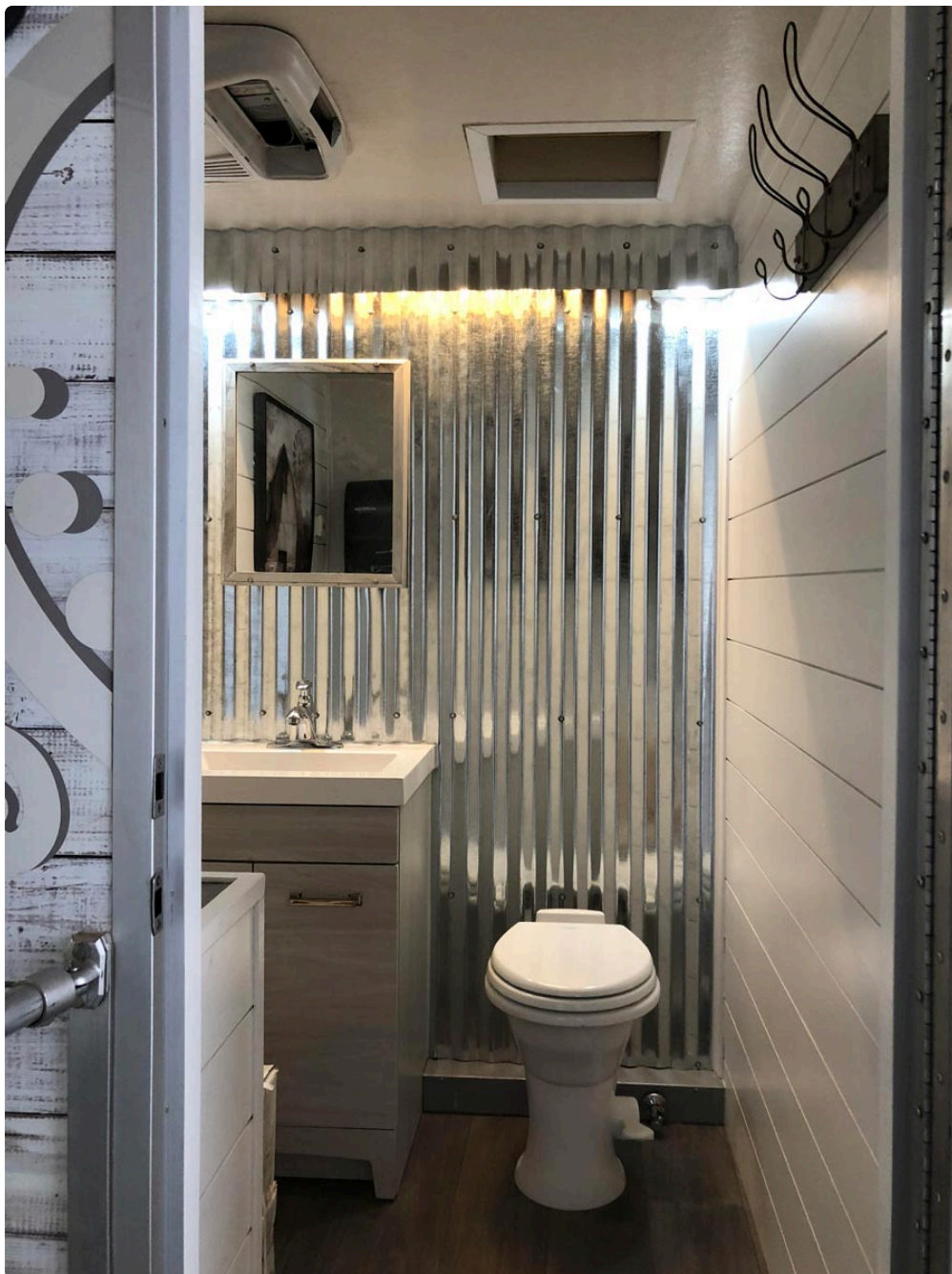
